Thank you for your interest in the Union Bank Scholarship Program. We are pleased to offer this program to the Class of 2020. Various scholarships will be awarded based on the number of qualified applicants. This scholarship is open to all graduating seniors that are graduating from a school that is within Union Bank's service market and are enrolled in a University, Community College, or a Vocational College/training program for the fall of 2020. Family members of Union Bank employees are not eligible for this program.

Attached you will find a scholarship application. In addition to completing this form, you must also include two letters of recommendation from members of the community (non-family), a copy of your academic transcript, and a short essay (250 to 500 words) answering the question "Where do you see yourself in 10 years?"

Scoring Criteria:

- Demonstration of community involvement and leadership skills.
- Demonstration of dedication to learning and education.
- Not required, but preference will be given to applicants that fit within Union Bank's mission of serving Michiganders that have a passion and careers in fields where they make, build and grow for a living.
- Applicant or parents of the applicant are customers of Union Bank, however this is not a requirement.

If you are awarded a scholarship, you will need to provide an acceptance letter before the award can be issued. Payment will be made directly to the school you have selected and it must be used before December 31, 2020.
